IN VANCOUVER

This Vancouver Youth Hostel is located in a central Vancouver location close to bus stops and offers a internet access (free WI-FI), air conditioning, breakfast included, common room, bicycle storage, laundry, elevator, linen included, luggage storage, tourist info, and a TV room. Shared rooms are \$38.50 Canadian per person per night.

They also offer a discount off their regular rates for groups of 10 or more people. Camping: On the Sunshine coast there are two provincial parks near Sechelt; Porpoise Bay \$25.00 a site and Roberts Creek \$16.00 a site (Canadian prices). A site includes four adults and one vehicle. Reservations are accepted at Porpoise Bay but not at Roberts Creek.
