## Young Life Camp in Progress in Liberia

Dear Faithful friends and partners,

I hope you are all doing well. I am so excited to tell you about something that I am convinced would be worth your prayers – **Young Life Liberia 2008 Youth camp!**

Since our first ever Young Life Liberia camp( in March 2007), our ministry has been challenged, equipped, prepared and blessed abundantly by God. One highlight has been the relationships that God has helped us build with so many kids last year. We were able to love and build friendships with lost kids for the God's Kingdom.

We are having two camps from Feb. 25 to March 2, 2008. We are expecting 250 kids and 50 persons composed of YL local leaders and work crew teams. The first 125 kids will attend the first camp from Feb. 25 to 27, while the second group of 125 kids will attend the second camp from Feb. 29 to March 2.

About three YL staff people from the US are coming to serve as the program team and work crew. I will be one of the camp speakers, while Zinnah Yallah (one of my key leaders) will be another speaker.

Roland Harris, also a key local leader will be our camp coordinator. Please pray for the camp leadership, the kids, staff, the volunteer leaders and the American team. Also, I want you to pray for

getting water for showering and washing. There is no running water at the camp. The camp has one well. We are in the dry season, and unlike last year, the well water



is unclear and muddy. We are working on getting a water tank at the camp to store water. Please for the provision of water and camp tents for kids to stay in. It is a big problem to get enough water for washing and showering at the camp. We are asking local people here to help with this situation and are also praying that the Lord will make this provision possible.

This year's camp promises to be an unforgettable one. We are expecting big thing from the Lord. Until then, please keep us in your prayers. Blessings,
