### Tanzania Camp 2007

More than thirty **YoungLife** supporters from the United States served as "work crew" for the all-African-led **YoungLife** camp. They assisted the African volunteers and staff in serving more than 250 teens from Tanzania who attended the camp at the Silver Sands motel, located on the Indian Ocean about five miles from the Young Life Africa Training Center in Dar Es Salaam. The camp was divided into two portions, one serving teens from the Arusha area (in the northern part of Tanzania) and the other serving teens from the Dar Es Salaam area. <><



The **Crossroads** Church Body has done much to make it possible for **Young Life** staff and volunteers to reach "Every Kid for Eternity" on the continent of Africa through their prayers and financial support. Financial support has aided the Larneys during their move from Ethiopia to Tanzania as well as helping maintain the **YoungLife** Training Center in Dar Es Salaam, where the Larney family lives on the second floor. Steve and Dyan's focus has been to train Africans to reach kids for Christ.
