Note: Via the generous support of individuals and businesses who believe in the value of the Young Life camp experience, the cost of leaders attending camp is not part of your child’s camp cost, and additional scholarship funds are available to assist you.

Your child can go! It’s easy, and here’s how we’ll do it...

- First, get your \$50 deposit to a Young Life leader soon. Spots are limited and all those who have their registration form and a \$50 deposit in by Tuesday, March 31st, will be entered into a drawing for one \$100 camp scholarship from our Area office! (Deposits and Registration forms are welcome following this date.) Talk to a Young Life leader about the many fundraising events that will be happening in the coming months. From magazine sales, to garage sales, to car washes and walk-a-thons, there are more than enough opportunities for a person to not only raise the residual cost of camp, but also earn their deposit back.
