WORK CREW PHILOSOPHY

Simply stated, the Young Life Work Crew experience is designed to provide each young person with a unique "once in a lifetime" opportunity involving the following areas:

- WORKING** They are most often the background people who do all the big and little things which keep the camp in good working order and thereby enable the rest of the staff to be free to spend their time getting involved with camp kids. For many, this is a chance to learn what it means to really work. This is not an opportunity to "counsel" or spend lots of time with campers or expect lots of free time.
- SELLING** The camp program and the message of Jesus Christ by their enthusiasm and spirit.
- PRAYING** For little things, for each other, for campers, for big things.
- LIVING** And sharing together in the joys and sorrows of each other's lives --- learning what it means to be a "body of Christ."
