### Entry Fee (No Refunds)

\$125.00 per boat must accompany application. No mail-in entry will be accepted post-marked after April 12, 2008. Registrations will be accepted at the Captains dinner, no later than 8:00 pm

### Participation:

Open to anyone 18 years of age or older or, if under 18, must have consenting adult fishing with him/her. Coast Guard regulations will prevail for # of participants per boat. Tournament directors reserve the right to interpret these regulations and may disqualify a boat at their sole discretion.

### Safety:

All boats must have USCG equipment as required by law for their class. All boats must be operated under USCG safety guidelines. No alcoholic beverages allowed.

### Boats and Motors:

Any boat 16 feet or longer is allowed, as long as it has the required horsepower per USCG. Aerated livewells are required. No canoes, kayaks, airboats or pontoon boats are allowed.

### Tackle and Equipment:

Anglers may use artificial lures, live bait and dead bait. All fish must be caught alive by rod and reel. No fishing within 50 yards of another contestant provided he is anchored with his trolling motor up.

### Scoring:

- Redfish must measure 18" minimum and less than 27" with a pinched, swiped tail. Flounder must measure 12". Trout must measure 15".
- For Large Mouth Bass: No fish under 14 inches. The state regulation of only one fish over 22 inches will NOT be waived for this tournament
- Undersized fish will result in disqualification from the tournament
- You must arrive to the weigh – in by 3:00 by water. You may not trailer to weigh-in. If you are late, you will be disqualified.
- When you come to the scales, please announce your team number and how many fish you have LOUDLY so all the tournament personnel hear you.
- Weight will be determined by pounds and ounces, to the nearest 100<sup>th</sup>.

This is a **CATCH AND RELEASE** tournament. All live fish must be released by tournament officials.

All anglers are subject to a polygraph test.

### Protest:

There are two times during this contest in which you can register a protest. The first, is before we officially end the Captain's meeting on Friday evening for any infraction that may have incurred prior to the beginning of the contest. The second for registering a protest is immediately after the weigh-in of the last boat's catch and before the awards presentation begins. Once the awards presentation begins, all results of the contest are considered fair and final.
